The ETNZ Community Theatre Technical Achievement Award recognises an individual who has achieved technical excellence in the technical area of community theatre. Award winners will meet the following criteria:

- they will be working in a volunteer capacity on the productions,
- they will have consistently delivered at a level of excellence throughout their time in community theatre, and
- they will have sought to promote best practice and technical excellence while delivering a high-quality performance.

Award Categories:

- **ETNZ Community Theatre Technical Achievement Award**
Open to all ages.
- **ETNZ Community Theatre Technical Achievement Award – Youth**
Open to those under 25 years of age who are new participants working on productions within the last one-two years. *Note: a youth nomination will not be considered for the general award.*

Nomination Process:

Nominations can be made by an MTNZ Society or an ETNZ member engaging in a professional capacity on community productions.
